Professor Fehily is the Clinical Director and lead surgeon at The Manchester Hip Clinic. He specialises in surgery of the hip and has a particular interest in hip preserving or key-hole surgery and innovative hip replacements. He is one of the leading hip arthroscopy surgeons in the UK and The Manchester Hip Clinic one of the highest volume centres in the country. He has pioneered the use of stem cells in hip surgery to regenerate cartilage damage. He has pioneered the use Robotics in hip replacements and was the first person to carry out a MAKO robotic hip replacement in the North West of England. Professor Fehily treats patients from all over the UK and internationally. He is the lead hip surgeon for the Hip and Groin Clinic, for the English Institute of Sport (Manchester), for the Armed Forces (Northern) and is a registered Consultant in the United Arab Emirates, having practiced in Dubai. He is the lead on many surgeon education courses, training other consultants from all over the UK and Europe in both key-hole and hip replacement techniques. He regularly treats high-level athletes, including Commonwealth, World Championship, Olympic and Premier League competitors.
